



Refund Policy

Our **Refund Policy** Has Been and Remains As Follows:

It is customary for Bloomington Gold to issue refunds to people who are on the Wait List and do not get judged. However, once an entrant is in the class, and withdraws (for any reason) they are **not** able to get their money back. (This is to prevent past abuses by owners who register a number of cars just to hedge their chances of getting "something" registered; then they withdraw all other cars around this time of year.)

PERSON WHO HAS BEEN PLACED IN A CLASS AND NOT ON THE WAIT LIST:

Bloomington Gold has a **NO REFUND** Policy. There will be no refunds on any cancellation or withdrawal taken after a car has been placed in the class to be judged.

***NOTE: If you cancel your registration but still want to attend the show, a person needs to notify the office that the Gold Passes need to be sent to them.*

WAIT LIST POLICY:

What happens if a person is placed on the wait list:

- **Stay on the wait list and see if they get in.** *In past years, almost every wait listed person shows their car, due to people dropping out.* A person can withdraw at any time up to the day of the show and request one of the next two options. People on the wait list will be notified via telephone or email as they move up or into the class.
- **"3 Strikes and You're In":** Have all fees paid this year credited to next year's registration fees. The probabilities of the person getting in next year are higher. Should that person be unlucky next year, they are guaranteed a spot in the third year. *If they don't choose this option, they start all over next year!!*
- **Withdraw and receive a complete refund** of all registration and handling fees. Requests should be made in writing and include credit card information. Requests for refunds must be emailed or sent to the office.

LETTERS OF CREDIT:

Letters of Credit for the following year can be issued under certain circumstances.

A letter requesting that the registration be cancelled must be sent to the Bloomington Gold office. If approved, the registration fees paid can be left with Bloomington Gold and the person will bring the same Corvette (same VIN) for judging in the following year. Entrants must re-register in the following year, and the credit will be applied toward judging event registration fees. This Letter of Credit is non-transferable to another car or person. However, previous registrations do not "count" as in the "Three Strikes" program.
